Yes, celebrate and let Pride be what you want it to be, but let's not forget our roots and those who came before us. Let's not lose sight of what Pride is first and foremost about.

Aims

Warwickshire Pride is a charity working with and for LGBT+ people in Warwickshire. Warwickshire Pride promotes acceptance, understanding and respect of LGBT+ people.

Information

The **lost child** and **lost property** point is at the information stall, marked on the site map included in this Pride Guide.

Toilets are located along the path that runs alongside Dormer Place. All toilets are gender neutral and there is an accessible toilet available. A Mobiloo with a hoist and changing bench is also located next to the First Aid ambulance. There are also toilets inside the Pump Rooms.

First Aid is available from 365 Medical Services. They are located close to the vehicle entry/exit point (please refer to site map).

Please dispose of **rubbish** in the bins provided. Littering is not ok and it's unfair on volunteers who have to tidy up after everyone. We also get charged if the site is not left clean, which as a charity is an expense we don't want. So, please be responsible. Use the bins or take rubbish away.

Warwickshire Pride is completely **family friendly** and all people are welcome to enjoy the Pride celebrations.

Well behaved **dogs** are allowed on site and must be kept on leads. Please also clean up after your dogs.

The festival site is **accessible**. Please contact us if you require any further information.

An **information stall** is located on the festival site. Please refer to the map and stalls list on pages 12 -14 of this event guide to see its location.

Alcohol will be on sale from our Pride bar. There will be a Challenge 25 policy in operation, so please bring ID if you are lucky enough to look under 25. Please drink responsibly and be considerate of other people. Anyone too heavily under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave.

Warwickshire Pride runs from 11:00am - 6:00pm. As it takes place in a residential area, please respect local residents by leaving quietly.

It's back by popular demand... There will once again be a Pride March through the heart of Leamington Spa!

The march is free for members of the public to take part in. It starts at 11:00am and the route is:

Beauchamp Road

Clarendon Avenue

Parade

Dormer Place

Pump Room Gardens.

This is a walking march, so people and pooches only. Please assemble any time between 9:00pm - 11:00am on the day on Beauchamp Road. Our team will be getting everyone into order, so please listen to what they say.

Bring signs, placards and flags. Feel free to dress up and get into the Pride spirit.

If there are any anti-LGBT+ protesters at the march, our advice is to ignore them and keep walking. There will be a Police presence in the town centre and they will take any action that is required to deal with anti-LGBT+ protestors.

Come and be part of something fabulous and a first for Warwickshire Pride and for Warwickshire!

You don't have to be LGBT+ to take part.

There are no age restrictions.

The march is fully accessible.

A team of stewards will be on hand to assist anyone who needs help.

If it's a hot day, drink plenty of water and put on some sun cream.

If it's raining, take an umbrella and still get involved.





Bi+ and Trans Tents

As part of our commitment to ensure Warwickshire Pride is as welcoming as possible to the whole LGBT+ spectrum, this year we once again have Bi+ and Trans Tents.

The Bi+ and Trans Tents are safe, welcoming space for anyone who identifies as bi+/pan or trans. Allies are also welcome on the understanding the tents a bi+ and trans safe spaces.

We recognise that Pride is about more than white gay men. Although it's important that Pride does cater for that part of the community, it's equally important that everyone else who comes under the LGBT+ umbrella is represented at Pride too, especially groups under attach, as trans people are, and groups subject to many myths and lack of understanding, such as bi+ people.

The Bi+ Tent will feature information and education, and interactive elements such as writing what being bi+ or pan means to you.

The Trans Tent will feature seating to chill out in a safe, welcoming and non-judgemental space, in addition to a changing space and clothing station where trans people can take away clothes for free, donate clothes to others, or exchange clothes. Information on local services will be available too.




Youth Tent at Warwickshire Pride




